

**Graduate Student Request
for No-Cost/No-Credit Religion Course**

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Graduate students enrolled in a degree-seeking graduate program and registered for at least 2.0 credit hours in a semester or 1.0 credit hour in a term are eligible to attend religion courses, on a space available basis, with instructor approval, and without incurring any additional tuition costs.

Note: This no-credit, no-cost option does not carry official registration recognition. It will not appear on your official records, will not be considered in calculating enrollment verifications, and does not fulfill the minimum registration requirement for graduate degree-seeking students.

Instructions: Student completes request from Graduate Studies (105 FPH, 422-4091); the office retains a copy of the form. Student requests approval from the religion instructor during the first ten class days of a semester, six days of a term. If the request is approved, either the student or the instructor returns the card to the Graduate Studies office. You do not need to register for the class through AIM.
